We were paid off

to send you \$150. to the address
of Edwin Hotchkiss - Am busy
now making out the acct. or would
write more - Am glad the time
has come when I can remember
you in this most satisfactory
manner - We have a rainy day
but the weather is mild -
Health all right - No other
news - Mail last night but
nothing for me
