Jan. 27th, 1863

My Dear Wife –

We were paid off yesterday up to Oct. 31st – or for one month & 23 days – My amount after deducting for the income tax was \$190.03 – I shall go to Acquia Creek Landing tomorrow with the money of the company that is to be sent home & remit by express – Intend to send you \$150 to the address of Edwin Hotchkiss – Am busy now making out the acct. or would write more – Am glad the time has come when I can remember you in this most satisfactory manner – We have a rainy day but the weather is mild – Health all right – no other news – mail last night but nothing for me –
